Big Idea: Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus. – Philippians 2:5

Text: Luke 9:46-62

I. HUMBLE _____ TOWARD OUR CHURCH FAMILY.

An argument started among the disciples as to which of them would be the greatest. – Luke 9:46

Jesus, knowing their thoughts, took a little child and had him stand beside him. Then he said to them, “Whoever welcomes this little child in my name welcomes me; and whoever welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me. For he who is least among you all—he is the greatest.” – Luke 9:47-48

II. GRACIOUS _____ TOWARD OTHER BELIEVERS.

“Master,” said John, “we saw a man driving out demons in your name and we tried to stop him, because he is not one of us.”

“Do not stop him,” Jesus said, “for whoever is not against you is for you.” – Luke 9:49-50

III. GRACIOUS _____ TOWARD UNBELIEVERS.

As the time approached for him to be taken up to heaven, Jesus resolutely set out for Jerusalem. And he sent messengers on ahead, who went into a Samaritan village to get things ready for him; but the people there did not welcome him, because he was heading for Jerusalem. When the disciples James and John saw this, they asked, “Lord, do you want us to call fire down from heaven to destroy them?” – Luke 9:51-54

But Jesus turned and rebuked them, and they went to another village. – Luke 9:55-56

Philip went down to a city in Samaria and proclaimed the Christ there. When the crowds heard Philip and saw the miraculous signs he did, they all paid close attention to what he said. With shrieks, evil spirits came out of many, and many paralytics and cripples were healed. So there was great joy in that city. – Acts 8:5-8

But when they believed Philip as he preached the good news of the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women. – Acts 8:12
